Dear Potential Member,

Thank you for your enquiry - you are welcome to come along for a game as a visitor anytime to see if you are interested in joining.

After that, you can play 2 more games before deciding if you do wish to join. If so, you can then complete the application form and pay for membership.

You will, however, need to complete 6 score cards before being allocated a handicap.

It is a requirement that you are able to complete 9 holes with a gross score of less than 70 and a handicap of no more than 20 in order to keep groups moving and to complete our competition play in a reasonable time.

We play early mornings (first hit off) every Monday and Thursday with registration times varying with the season – from 5.45 to 6.15 am in summer and 7.00 to 7.30 am in winter.

When you arrive, please pay your green fees and fill out a card from the Pro Shop (Let them know you are playing with the Seniors group for a discount), then find our registration table either in the lounge behind the café or at the tables outside – look for our blue shirts!

Let the person on the registration table know that you have been in contact with me and that you are having a game as a potential member.

Game day fee (paid at registration) is \$2.00 (voucher) to cover prizes etc. for the day's competition.

The club is cash-free, and vouchers are available for purchase at the registration desk.

Please see overleaf for the cost of membership and apparel – club shirts and badges are mandatory.

We are a social club as much as a sports club and members are encouraged to stay behind for presentations after each game, and to attend extra events including 'Away' games, Sundowners. Novelty events and occasional mid-week lunches.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

- The club runs 3 grades of players (A, B & C).
- Competitions on each playing day vary between: Stroke, Stableford, Progressive Stableford, Par, Par Bisque, Stroke & Putts, 2 ball multiplier, 4 or 2 ball ambrose - a schedule is issued 4 monthly. (Fear not – scoring will be explained to you on the day by your friendly playing partner)
- At registration, you will be placed in a group of 4 (different each time to enable meeting all members of the club) and you will be paired to mark a partner's card.
- At the conclusion of each day's competition, prizes are awarded for grade winners and for 'side' competitions of: closest to the pin on par 3 holes, longest putt on hole 9, longest drive on selected days, birdies, eagles, ferrets & golden ferrets. A raffle draw is also held for 4 lucky winners.
- Each month there are two stroke play rounds, which count towards annual championship awards, with a bottle of wine or equivalent awarded to each grade winner on one of those rounds.
- Annual awards are for the overall Club Champion, Grade & Best Putter Champions, most improved and finally the President's award for outstanding service to the Club.
- An eclectic competition for each grade is also run throughout the year – this is your best score on each hole on each course over the playing year, which is updated each playing date by our very clever computer registration and scoring system.
- Summer & Spring Cup annual match-play tournaments in each grade are held (concurrently with general competitions). We also hold a 'Clarke Simmons' Charity Day (4 ball ambrose competition) and sometimes a 'Bridging the Gap' competition with young players from the Como School Golf Academy.
- The Club financial year runs from July 1st through to June 30th, whereas the competition playing year runs from October 1st through to September 30th.
- Our Trophy/Christmas night is held in late November or early December.
- The Club is not registered with Golfing Australia & handicaps are not transferable to other Clubs.
